Synopsis

Lukas breaks free from his abuser's grip, Oliver turns his life around, and they reunite. Together, they not only get to know each other but come to a better understanding of themselves in the process.

Alexander Lincoln / Oliver

Alexander appeared in the recent Hallmark film series *The Groomsmen* and was the star of the hit gay rugby feature *In From The Side* for which he was nominated for Breakthrough Performance at the British Independent Film Awards.

Best known for the role of Jamie Tate in the ITV1 show *Emmerdale*, which he played for over 302 episodes from 2019 to 2021, he also appeared in the BBC1/NBC show *Everything I know About Love*, starring Emma Appleton and Bel Powley and the

Jack Brett Anderson / Lukas

A rising star in both theatre and film, Jack caught the eye of critics in his debut theatre role as Prince Edward in Christopher Marlowe's *Edward II* in 2011.

Since then, Jack has starred in several BBC productions, including a guest lead in the popular drama *Casualty* and his best-known role, as the teen wolf Matei, in the critically acclaimed and award-winning fantasy *Wolfblood*.

Jack's latest television characters are in the period drama series Genius: Picasso, The Great with Elle Fanning and Nicholas Hoult and Sky Atlantics' Domina

David Bradley / John

David Bradley is known for his screen roles including Argus Filch in the *Harry Potter* film series, Walder Frey in the HBO fantasy series *Game of Thrones*, and Abraham Setrakian in the FX horror series *The Strain*. He has also made several appearances as the First Doctor in *Doctor Who*.

He won a BAFTA in 2014 for best supporting actor in the award-winning series *Broadchurch*, and he received an Annie Award in 2021 for Best Voice Actor in a Television Series for his work as Merlin in Guillermo del Toro's animated Netflix series *Tales of Arcadia*.

An alumnus of the Royal Shakespeare Company, Bradley is also an established stage actor, with a career that includes a Laurence Olivier Award for his role in a production of King Lear.

Jimmy Ericson / Daniel

Jimmy graduated from the University of Northampton Acting course in 2021. He has completed five tours working with Solomon Theatre Company and starring in the successful plays *Power of Love* and *Skin Deep*.

After working on a few short films, this will be his debut role in a feature film.

Beth Rylance / Emma

Beth is an actress and writer. She primarily works in comedy and has appeared in episodes of BBC Laugh Lessons, Comedy Central's *Every Blank Ever* and *The B@IT*. Other credits include *Ministry of Curious Stuff* and *Turn Up Charlie* on Netflix.

Rylance also teaches workshops at the School of Comedy, a London-based school that teaches children improv, sketch and standup comedy. She was a member of the school's original troupe who performed at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe in 2007 and starred in a brief TV show.

Beth's recent TV credits include roles in Series 2 of Amazon's *Good Omens* as well as in Disney+ comedy series *Extraordinary*.



Filmmakers

Diego Scerrati - Producer/Writer

Driven by a passion for storytelling and a commitment to amplifying underrepresented voices, Diego began his career as a film journalist and script editor in Italy before moving to London, where he founded Monteverde Pictures — a production company dedicated to championing diverse perspectives and collaborating with emerging talents.

His debut feature, A Night Like This (previously called On A Winter Night), won Best Script at the LGBTQ+ Film Festival in Toronto and is currently in post-production. The film was also selected for the prestigious "Work in Progress Showcase" at the 2024 London Film Festival and the completed film screened at the BFI Flare Festival.

With three additional projects in development, Monteverde Pictures continues to push boundaries, further solidifying its vision of creating bold and inclusive cinema.

Liam Calvert - Director

Liam Calvert is a director and writer originally from Leeds. He studied Film and Television at Solent University in Southampton, where he initially focused on editing. However, his passion for directing and writing emerged after writing the World War II short film Gisette.

Liam then pursued an MA in Film Production, during which he created 24 Hours at the Giddy Bridge, a workplace documentary that follows the staff of the pub where he worked while studying.

After graduating, he directed another short film, a zombie drama titled 1 in 6, before relocating to London and beginning work on his first feature film, *A Night Like This*.

Reece Cargan – Co-Producer

Reece is a BAFTA-nominated and RTS award-winning producer. He was selected by Screen International as a Scotland Rising Star and by the British Film Institute as an Insight Producer for 2023.

He has produced numerous award winning shorts and recently co-produced his first two features: *Midwinter Break*, a dramatic feature directed by Polly Findlay with financing from Film4 and Focus Features to be released in 2025; and *Where Dragons Live* directed by Suzanne Raes – a documentary which premiered at Sheffield DocFest.

A proud alumnus of EAVE Producer's Workshop, Rotterdam Lab, BFI Insight, ACE Eu mentoring and Torino Film Lab, Reece is passionate about working with and turning up the volume of the next generation of Queer UK talent, with a focus on intersectional LGBTQIA+ stories and voices.

James Heath - Co-Producer

James is a BAFTA-nominated producer of SXSW award-winning film The Fitzroy written and directed by Andrew Harmer.

He is the producer of Spilt Milk which will premiere at this year's Glasgow and Dublin film festivals and upcoming titles Leonora In The Morning Light and The Draw.

She is currently working on the development of Monteverde Pictures' projects slate, alongside Founder and Director Diego Scerrati.

Oliver Bury - Director of Photography/Editor

Oliver is a multi-skilled director, cinematographer, and editor. He has produced, shot, and edited hundreds of commercial and promotional work as well as award-winning short films, feature-length fiction and music videos.

Some of these include Hugo Boss, Porsche, Barclays, BBC, Sky Arts, Sky 1. His main goal is to focus on creating beautifully cinematic, engaging content with a strong emphasis on evoking an emotional response.

Jonny Martin - Composer

Jonny is a musician, songwriter, composer, and musical director. He worked on ITV1's The Voice while touring as support for Cyndi Lauper.

He had a song featured in the BAFTA award-winning short film *Home* and scored the feature *We're All Going To The World's Fair*, which screened at Cannes and Sundance.

His commercial credits include featuring all original compositions for ESPN, Century 21, Ford, and P&G among others.



Finding The Meaning of Life

Filmed across 23 different locations in London, *A Night Like This* stands as a testament to the joint effort of a collective of young emerging talents who connected online, drawn together by this atypical "on-the road" quest to find the meaning of life.

More than a nocturnal odyssey of two ordinary souls, *A Night Like This* is an honest portrayal of the mental struggles faced by a generation trying to find its place in an ever-evolving world.

A Night Like This is a story about depression but also new possibilities, where the chance encounter between two people leads them to confess, fall in love, and understand each other in one night.

The film explores the great mystery of each human being's role on this planet. Thanks to the multiple encounters that populate this film, the two protagonists will embark on a journey of self-discovery, unravelling the essence of their existence and embracing the profound significance of life itself.

Themes of abuse, gender disparity, love, pain, and depression converge in one night, a long night where the protagonists will discover an unexplored city, and rediscover their sense of wonder and trust, giving themselves a new beginning.

Why this film?

This is a tale of redemption, resilience, and the enduring power of human connection that transcends the boundaries of a world demanding ambition and self-fulfilment.

The protagonists are not heroes, but ordinary people with unconventional lifestyles that we can all relate to. In such difficult times, we believe we need stories and characters grounded in the real world that can inspire a new generation of adults, struggling to survive and finding a purpose or a future for themselves.

We have decided to tell this story from the point of view of two men, as we believe there is a significant opportunity in the LGBTQ+ genre. We want to challenge the idea that stories with gay characters can only speak to a specific community and can't address universal themes.

In over 40 years, only 16% of films featuring gay characters had a happy ending. Therefore, we believe it's time for this genre to step up and start telling stories that can resonate with everyone and do not consider sexuality or identity the only source of conflict for their characters.
